American Airlines check-in is available through several convenient methods. You can check in online using the American Airlines website starting **24 hours before your flight** departure. At that time, you can select your seat, pay for checked baggage, request upgrades, and generate your boarding pass. If you encounter issues such as difficulty logging into your reservation, problems downloading your boarding pass, or challenges paying for bags, you can call **+1-866-551-1186**. An agent will assist you through the process, help retrieve your reservation, and ensure you complete your American Airlines check-in successfully.

The **mobile app** offers nearly the same functionality as online check-in, including seat selection, bag payment, and digital boarding pass delivery that can be saved to your electronic wallet. If the app fails to retrieve your reservation or will not deliver the boarding pass, or if you face compatibility issues with your device, you can call **+1-866-551-1186**. At the airport, you have multiple check-in options. **Self-service kiosks** allow you to check in, print your boarding pass, and tag your luggage. **Ticket counters** provide personalized service for seat requests, itinerary changes, special assistance, and baggage drop. Some airports also offer **curbside check-in**, where staff handle your bags and issue your boarding pass before you enter the terminal. Understanding check-in deadlines is vital. AAdvantage elite members and passengers flying **First or Business Class** may use **priority check-in lines**, which are faster and provide enhanced service. If your status or cabin class isn't recognized at check-in—whether online, mobile, or at a kiosk—or if the boarding pass doesn't reflect priority boarding, call **+1-866-551-1186**. Agents can verify your status, request priority entitlements, or direct you to a special counter reserved for elite or premium passengers.

American Airlines also offers **Five Star Service**, a concierge-level experience available at select airports, designed for elite and premium travelers. This service includes expedited check-in, access to expedited security lines, lounge access, and personalized escort through the airport. The cost is typically around **\$350 per person**, or bookable with AAdvantage miles. It must be reserved **at least 24 hours before a domestic flight** and **48 hours before an international flight**. To arrange this service, you must call **+1-866-551-1186**, where dedicated agents can schedule, arrange payment, and confirm your Five Star Service.

If complications arise—such as name mismatches, missing documentation, boarding pass errors, seat assignment issues, or baggage disputes—you can call **+1-866-551-1186** for support. Agents can help correct your Passenger Name Record (PNR), issue a new boarding pass, adjust seat assignments, assist with upgrades, or coordinate special services like traveling with a pet, requesting a wheelchair, or arranging medical accommodations.
