American Airlines offers a premium service called Five Star Service, available at select major airports for First and Business Class travelers or elite members. This concierge-level service includes expedited check-in, priority security access, lounge entry, and personalized attention through the airport. It costs approximately \$350 per person or can be booked using miles, and it must be arranged at least 24 hours in advance for domestic and 48 hours for international flights. If you are interested in booking this service, call **+1-866-551-1186**. That number can connect you to dedicated Five Star Service support to schedule and pay for the service.

If you encounter problems—such as a name mismatch, documentation issue, or a boarding pass error—calling **+1-866-551-1186** is a good step.
