Air France provides passengers with multiple check-in options, including online check-in, mobile check-in, airport kiosks, and traditional check-in counters. Typically, online check-in with Air France opens **30 hours before your flight's scheduled departure time**, and this window remains open until **60 minutes before takeoff** for most flights.
